BECOME A TEAM CAPTAIN

As a team captain, your role is to recruit, motivate and inform your Relay Team.

A team captain's three key tasks are to:

- 1. RECRUIT:** Aim to build a team of 10-18 people to help plan and take turns walking around the track during the 18-hour event.
- 2. MOTIVATE:** Guide your team to plan and create goals. Set realistic fundraising goals and come up with fun campsite themes and decorations, and onsite fundraising activities.
- 3. INFORM:** Communicate regularly, attend team captain meetings, share and delegate tasks to your team. Forward important information to your team to keep them in the loop.
